### PROPOSED RESOLUTION

#### APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Public Employee Labor Relations Act (5 ILCS 315/1 et seq.) has established regulations regarding collective bargaining with a union; and

**WHEREAS**, Collective Bargaining Agreement for the period of December 1, 2012 through November 30, 2017 has been negotiated between the County of Cook/Sheriff of Cook County and the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) representing the Deputy Sheriffs; and

**WHEREAS**, salary adjustments and general wage increases have already been negotiated and are reflected in the Salary Schedules included in the Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated between the County of Cook/Sheriff of Cook County and the FOP; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Cook County Board of Commissioners does hereby approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the County of Cook/Sheriff of Cook County and the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police as provided by the Bureau of Human Resources.
