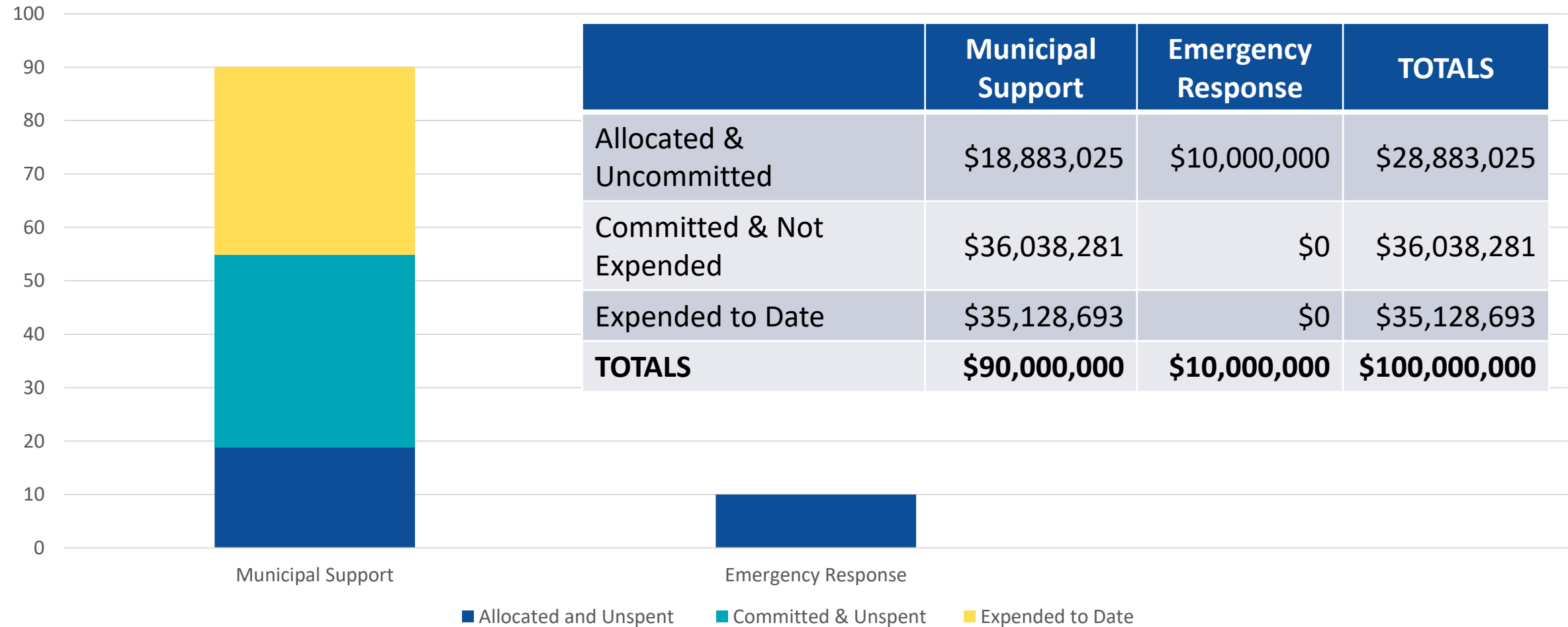
Quarterly Overview

- **Closeout of Round 1 – “New Arrivals”:** The City of Chicago and the Village of Oak Park have been closed out. EMRS continues the process of closing out the Village of Ford Heights.
- **New Grant Awards for Round 2 – “July '24 Storms”:** EMRS awarded \$854,402 in grants to 17 Municipalities to help combat the storms last summer.

DRRF Grant Awards: July '24

Storms

\$854,402 in grant awards approved!

Severe weather in Cook County: July 14th and July 15th with a damaging straight-line windstorm striking the region particularly hard.

Municipal assessments of damage: 23 suburban municipalities assessed **\$2.3m** in uninsured public infrastructure damages.

DRRF \$ made available : County makes funding available for reimbursement; application deadline of 1/17/25

Outreach efforts. Included Councils of Government calls to announce to mayors and managers, calls to County Commissioners, press release, and calls/visits made by EMRS staff (Regional Coordinators) to municipalities
