Dear Madam President and Cook County Commissioners:

The Department of Transportation and Highways submits for execution two (2) copies of an intergovernmental agreement with the Village of Schaumburg ("the Village"), wherein the County will be the lead agency for construction and construction engineering for a traffic signal replacement at the intersection of Roselle Road and Hartford Drive, partially funded with a federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant. At the request of the Village, the subject project contract will include installation of decorative sidewalk and a painted traffic signal system to maintain a uniform aesthetic within the Village. The Village of Schaumburg will reimburse the County of Cook for its share of construction and construction engineering costs for the requested aesthetic enhancements to the planned improvement, estimated total Village share \$35,167.00, under Cook County Section: 25-HSIP2-00-TL.

This Agreement is necessitated by the improvement which is needed to provide a safe, efficient and sustainable highway.

The Agreement has been examined and approved by this Department and by the State's Attorney's Office. I therefore respectfully recommends that it be executed in accordance with the accompanying Resolution, and that the two (2) originals be returned to this Department for final processing.
