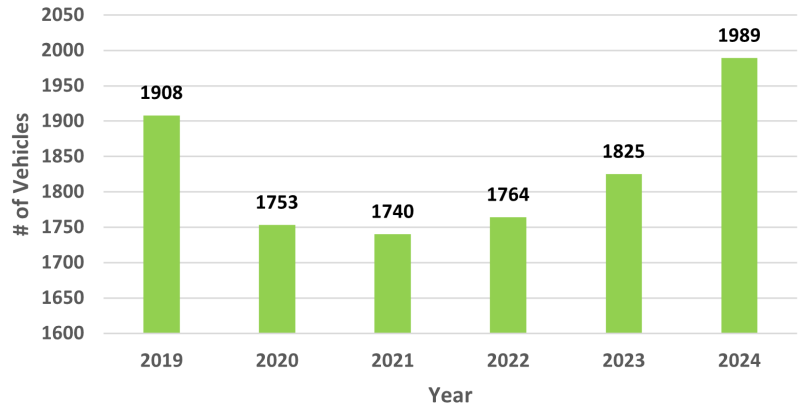




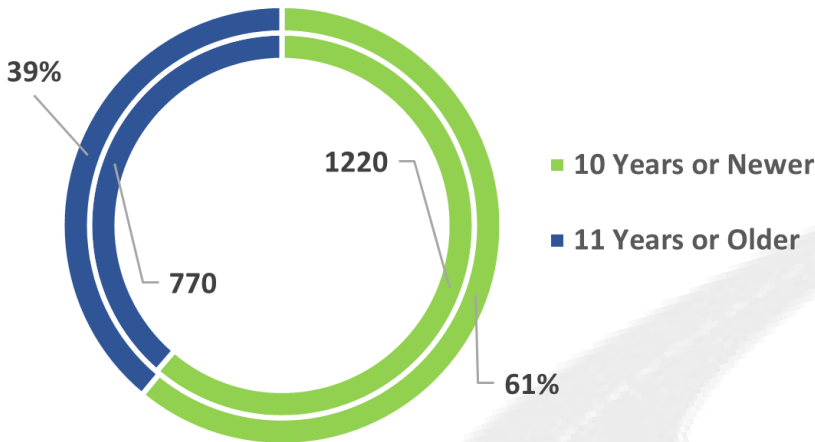
2024 Annual Countywide Fleet Inventory Report

Countywide Fleet Trend



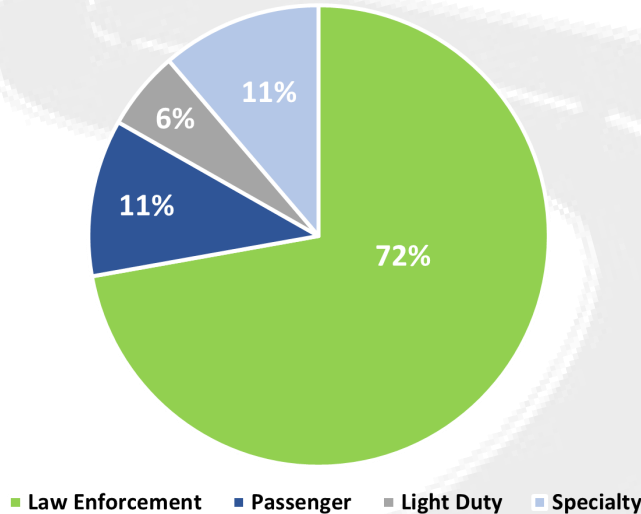
Age of Fleet

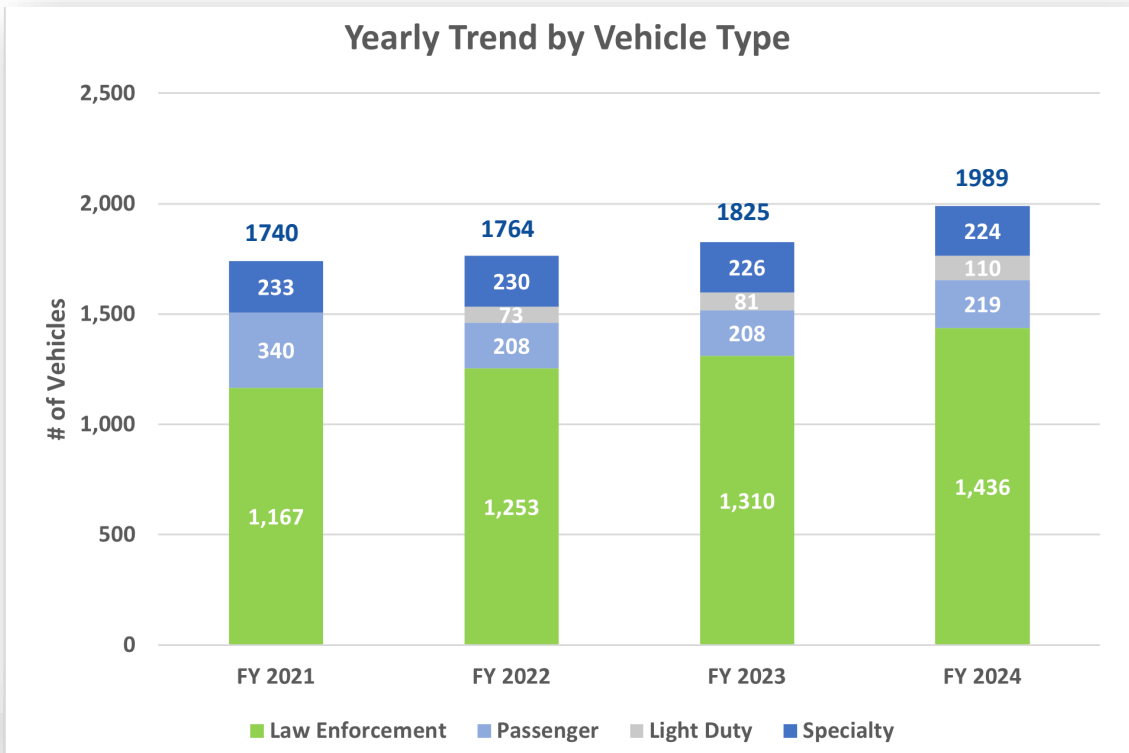

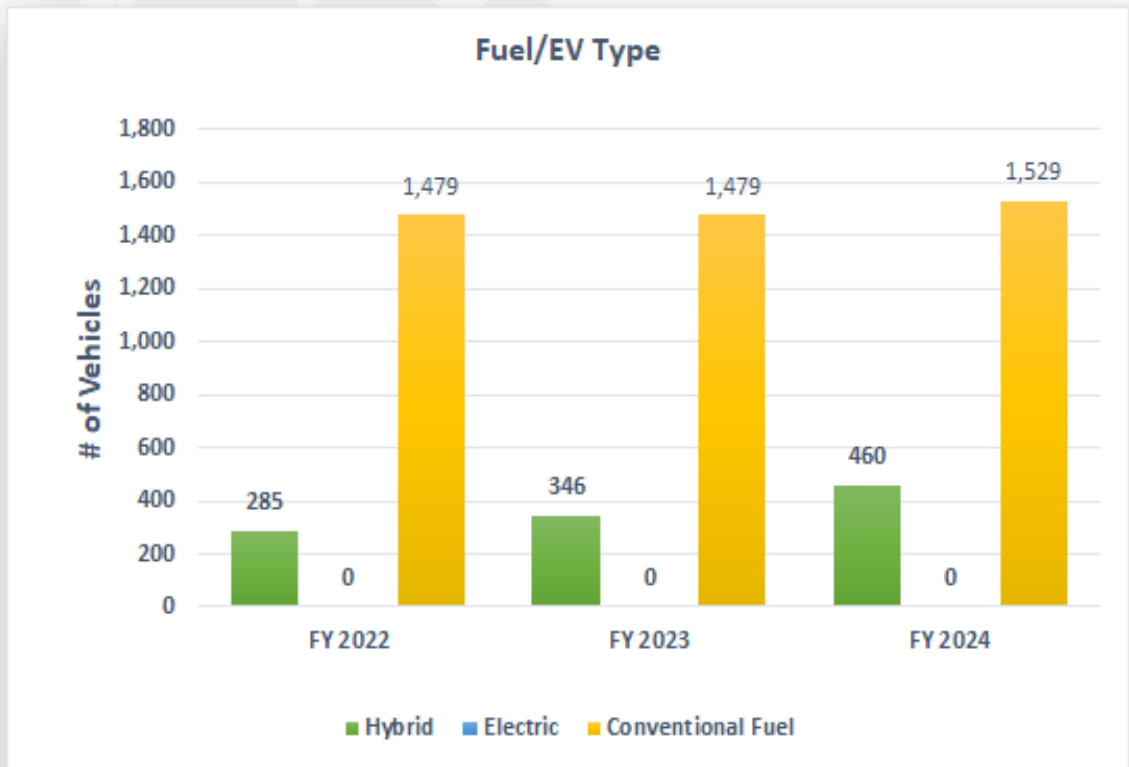
Vehicles 10 years or newer make up 61% of the County's fleet.
