Enclosed please find the Bond Series Status Report for the 2013 Fiscal Year, 3rd Quarter ending August 31, 2013, in accordance with FY 2013 Resolution Section Number 16. The report consists of two sections; the first section defines the funding status for Capital Improvement and the second section for Equipment. The report defines the bond funding status for equipment and projects approved by the Cook County Board of Commissioners. It presents the projected cost, adjustments to the projected cost, expenditures and commitments, unencumbered balances, existing funding resources and future funding resources required for the approved projects after the end of each quarter.

The amount spent since the last report was \$38,301,251, which means there is \$221,196,206 left in the Capital Improvement Fund and \$61,931,267 left in the Capital Equipment Fund. Attached is a list of the projects driving most of the spending for this quarter.
