#### Mental Health Services at the JTDC

- Mental Health (MH) Staff (Psychologists, Psychiatric Social Workers, Mental Health Specialists) on site: 7
   days per week; 365 days per year; There is an on-call Mental Health staff everyday
- Psychiatry coverage 5 days/week (Mondays Fridays): There is an on-call psychiatrist everyday
- All youth are given the Massachusetts Youth Screening Instrument 2 (MAYSI-2) within 4 hours of admission and a comprehensive face to face MH intake assessment within 72 hours of admission
- Youth identified as being in need of MH services are provided with comprehensive treatment plans and post release care coordination services
- The JTDC MH Program is accredited by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC)
- JTDC MH services include:
  - Individual counseling
  - Group counseling
  - Substance abuse services
  - Psychiatric services






