


- One of the most diverse and largest counties in the nation!
- Growth in Latinx, Asian, and Multi Racial residents
- "White" includes Arab and Middle Eastern residents
- "Black" includes both African Americans and African Immigrants
- "Asian" second level data on ethnicity (Indian, Vietnamese, etc) available soon from Census
- Black population stable decreased in Chicago (but increased in other cities across the County)
- Diversity in areas such as Albany Park, South/West Loop, North / Northwest Suburbs, Southwest Suburbs are not clearly understood

ILLINOIS POPULATION CHANGE










Illinois has the largest American Muslim per capita population in the US. Illinois Muslim communities are the most diverse in the nation: race, ethnicity, class, background




