Proviso Partners for Health (PP4H) is an identified and approved subrecipient of CCDPH's Contact Tracing Grant. PP4H is a multi-sector community coalition that promotes racial and economic opportunity through policy systems and environmental change. The Public Health Institute of Metropolitan Chicago (PHIMC) serves as PP4H's fiscal agent. PP4H is the only coalition in the State of Illinois trained in the Community of Solutions framework, a Robert Wood Johnson 100 Million Healthier Lives signature initiative. PP4H has coached 150 individuals and organizations to strengthen leadership and advanced health, well-being, and equity, and will be using the Community of Solutions Framework to also provide coaching to contact tracing staff. CCDPH's Contact Tracing Grant is expected to fund this project. This request is to add coaching sessions for contact tracing staff.

The vendor will support CCDPH in providing contact tracing staff with professional development opportunities by conducting an initial one-hour coaching session and a thirty-minute follow-up session.


