CCH Trauma-Informed Approaches Task Force



- Started in February 2019 with series of crosssector meetings
- Developed recommendations for executive leadership
- About 300 CCH staff trained on Trauma-Informed Care
- About 25 CCH staff trained as facilitators to lead Trauma-Informed Care 101 trainings
- Created self-care resources for individuals, managers, and for people providing patient care
