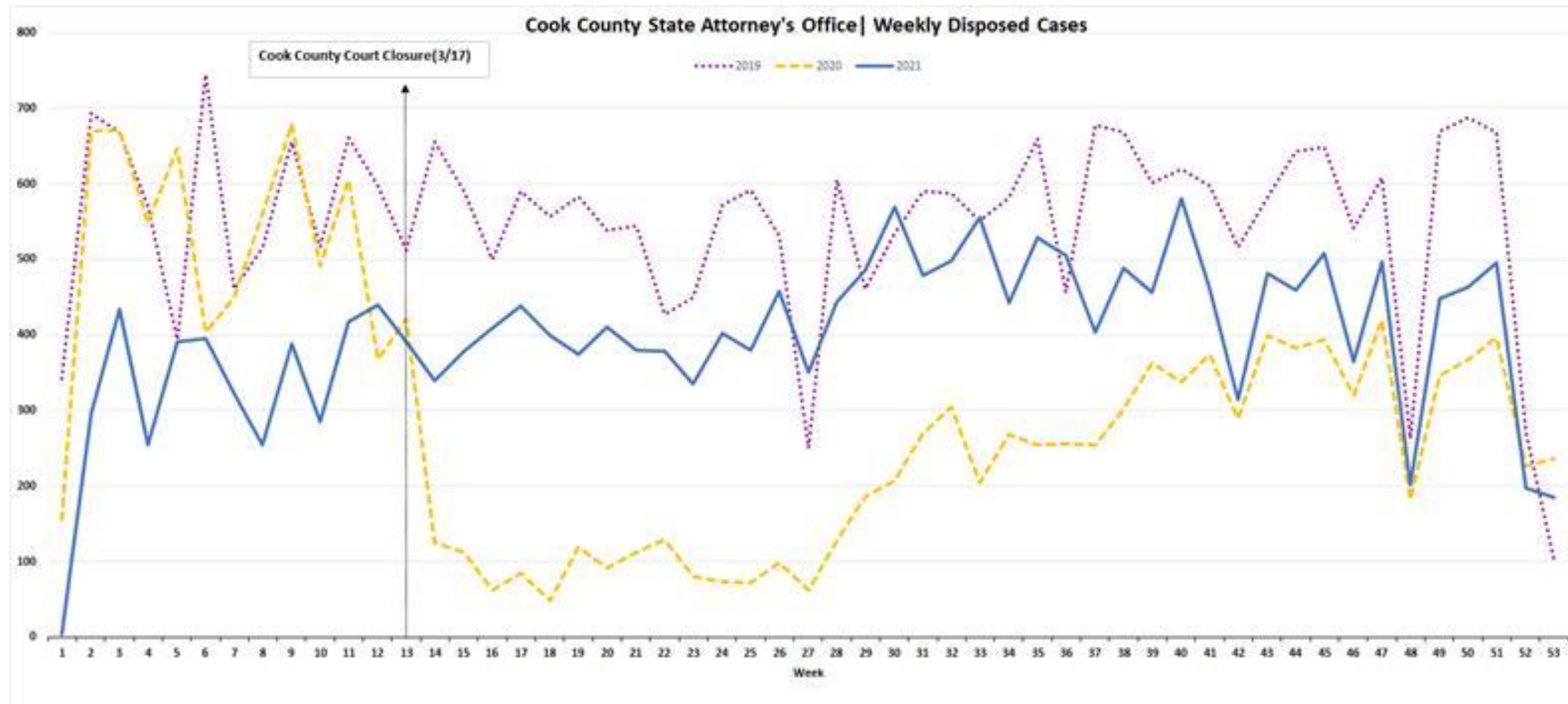

How CCSAO refers individuals to behavioral health services

- Behavioral and mental health services are subject to the cost of care established by the provider
 - Typically covered by private or state insurance
- CCSAO departments that refer to behavioral and mental health services:
 - Seniors and Persons with Disabilities Unit
 - Juvenile Justice Bureau
 - Victim Witness Unit
 - Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence Division
 - Alternative Prosecution and Sentencing Unit

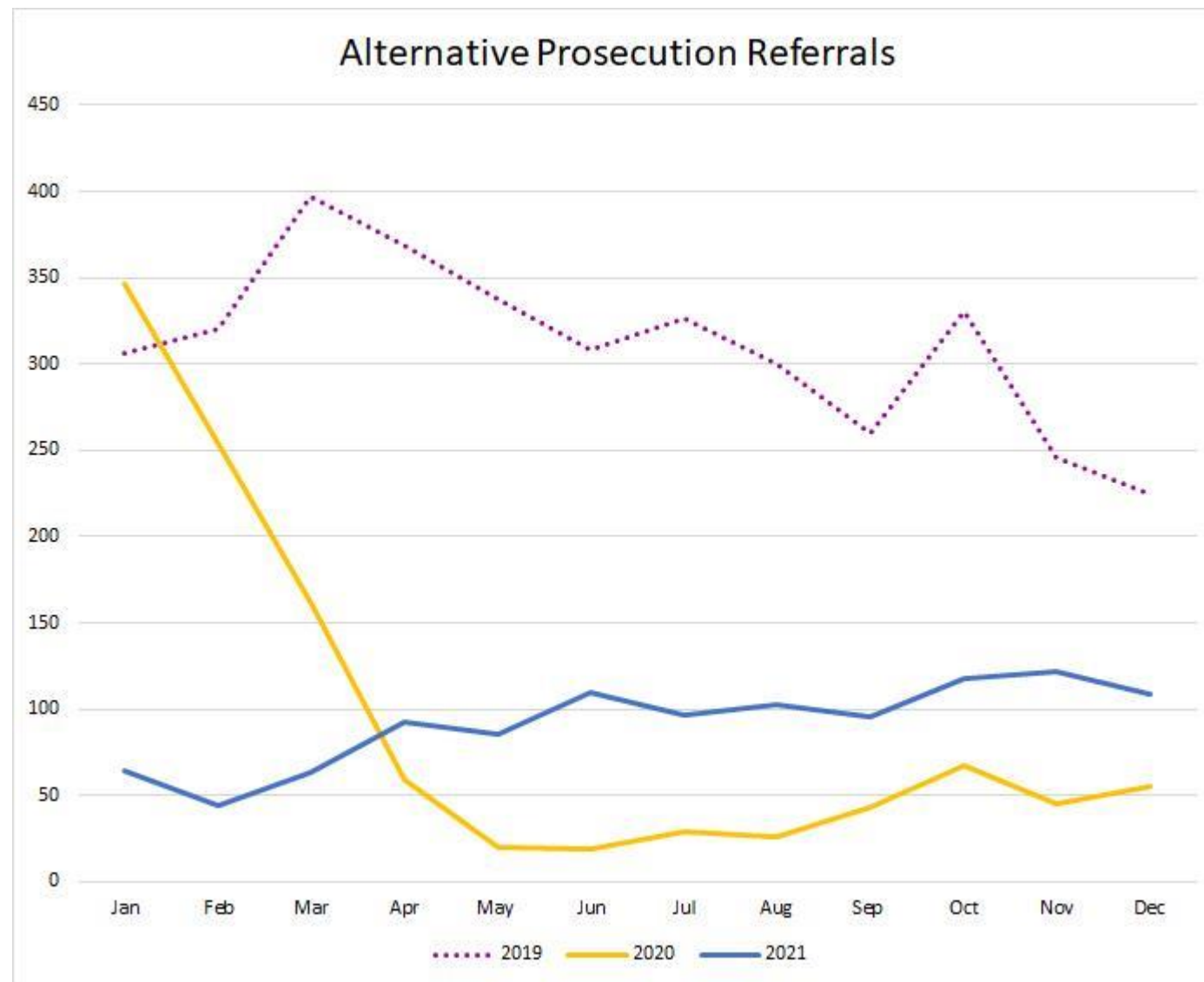
Updates Since November
