PROPOSED RESOLUTION

HOW PATIENTS GET REFERRED TO SHORT -AND LONG-TERM NURSING HOMES

WHEREAS, there is a lack of knowledge on how to ascertain accessibility to short- and long-term health care facilities; and

WHEREAS, there are an insufficient number of facilities throughout Cook County to address chronic illnesses; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to have highly trained and skilled social workers to aid families and patients on accessibilities to facilities or general health care information; and

WHEREAS, several initiatives to include quality care for nursing home patients is a challenge; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to have competitive wages in order to attract and retain social workers, registered nurses, and other professional services; and

WHEREAS, Medicare fails to cover a broad range of elderly's healthcare needs, such as long-term care, prescription drugs, dental care, basic preventive services, eyeglasses, and hearing aid; and

WHEREAS, Medicaid provides significant assistance for nursing homes and other long-term care expenses. However, restricted eligibility rules make benefits available to less than half of those with income below \$11,000; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Cook County Board of Commissioners request a convening of the Cook County Health and Hospitals to conduct a hearing regarding the lack of or inadequate nursing facility in Cook County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the hearing shall feature presentations, subject matter experts and individuals with lived experiences..
