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My name is Dinesh McCoy, and I work with an organization called Just Futures Law. I am speaking today in support of the resolution and to share some of the work that we have done in collaboration with Mijente.

In particular, I want to share details of how Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has used LexisNexis technology to target and surveil immigrants in Cook County. Through a Freedom of Information Act request with ICE, we have learned that ICE agents have run over 1.2 million searches around the country on LexisNexis' Accurint tool. Using Accurint, ICE can get information about people from 34 billion public and private records, and draws from hundreds of data sources for up-to-date information about potential targets, include residents of Cook County. In relation to Cook County specifically, in a 7-month period last year, ICE's Chicago offices ran over 30,000 searches and generated over 6,000 reports. 13,000 of these searches were conducted by ICE's Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) division, which is most directly responsible for facilitating ICE's deportation agenda.

These searches provide extremely invasive and personal information about ICE's targets— it includes information derived from private transactions like phone, internet, and utility purchases, and can provide ICE with a detailed map of a person's family, friends, and other associates.

I share this information in support of the resolution and ending any sharing of Cook County data with LexisNexis and ICE. LexisNexis is profiting through its ability to provide information that supercharges ICE's deportation agenda, and this commission must take action to protect all Cook County residents'.
