I mean we are dead my ancestors are ghosts they pass on the strength and identity the power of life. Soo many died in the indian was and the U.S. Govenments Indian Extermination chamaigns that nothing but fear and pain and sorrow and loss was passed on to us who came after. My people where cut from the tree they out side of the circle. And i died with them. I fucking refuse to assimilate and leave them alone in that darkness. So i will never be whole. I can not heal from a death that came 500 years ago.

"Our nation was born in genocide when it embraced the doctrine that the original American, the Indian, was an inferior race. Even before there were large numbers of Negroes on our shores, the scar of racial hatred had already disfigured colonial society. From the sixteenth century forward, blood flowed in battles of racial supremacy. We are perhaps the only nation which tried as a matter of national policy to wipe out its Indigenous population. Moreover, we elevated that tragic experience into a noble crusade. Indeed, even today we have not permitted ourselves to reject or feel remorse for this shameful episode. Our literature, our films, our drama, our folklore all exalt it."
