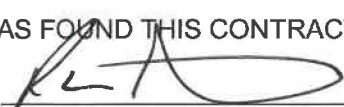

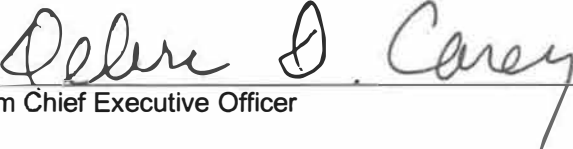

PRIOR CONTRACT HISTORY:
~~No prior contract history.~~ Contract number H20-25-062 was approved on March 31, 2020 pursuant to Cook County Board Presidential Executive Order 2020-4, in an amount not to exceed \$1,996,000.00 for a thirty-six (36) month period from 05/01/2020 through 04/30/2023. Amendments as specified in this request are needed to adjust the scope of the contract to address continuity of care services to be provided during the period of 02/01/2020 thru 04/30/2020.

NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:

This request will provide the following Care Coordination services in two phases. First to address continuity of care for a new member population in CountyCare and then as a fully delegated vendor beginning on May 1, 2020. The fully delegated services include: health risk screening and assessment, transition of care and care plan support, outreach and linkage to care, communication among disciplinary care teams, assistance with Medicaid re-determination, appointment support to close care gaps, participation in individualized Education Programs and 504 plans in schools, data collection and integration related to these activities.

This is sole source because pursuant to section 5.7.14 of the Department's HealthChoice Illinois contract with the County of Cook, CountyCare is required to contract with U of I Division of Specialized Care for Children (DSCC) to provide Care Coordination services to designated Special Needs Children populations.

Prior to the delegated services discussed above, and for the period beginning February 1, 2020 to April 30, 2020, DSCC will provide person- and family-centered care coordination services for the purposes of continuity of care for members transitioning into CountyCare. This is including, but not limited to, member engagement, assessment, care plans (including the identification of barriers and steps to overcome such barriers), referrals, coordination with providers, and support of general wellness of both member and caregiver. DSCC must also complete a readiness review audit, participate in CountyCare led trainings, and maintain a staffing ratio of 1:75. The cost of such continuity of care services is included in reflected in the Fiscal Impact Not-Exceed-Amount for FY2020.

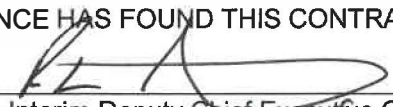
NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:
This is a request to execute a contract with Haymarket for the Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Center (SAMHSA) for the Cook County Offender Reentry Program (CCORP) grant. The Cook County Offender Reentry Program's (**CCORP**) focus over the next five years is to expand and sustain community treatment and services for 475 women offenders/ex-offenders with a Substance Use Disorder (SUD) or SUD with Co-Occurring Mental Health Disorder who are returning to Cook County, Illinois (IL) from the Logan Correctional Center ("Logan"), an Illinois Department of Corrections' (IDOC) female prison, and who face barriers accessing and remaining engaged in care.

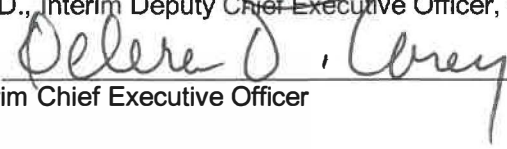
Haymarket will provide the following services: 1) Recovery Home Housing which provides a much needed housing component for ex-offenders who will benefit from a structured living environment during their recovery. The homes provide a safe and stable living environment in which participants acquire recovery skills for reentry into the community; 2) Transportation to pick up clients from the bus and train stations arriving from Logan Correctional facility in Lincoln Illinois to Chicago drive them to the Haymarket campus; 3) Project staff which will include a Project Director (PD) who will oversee the grant project and help to ensure the project stays on track to meet the proposed goals and objectives. The PD will oversee coordination of treatment and recovery home services at Haymarket Center as well as collaboration with CCHHS and IDOC partners and Outreach Worker who provides coordinated formal outreach services to prepare potential clients to accept services, and formal outreach services to triage and register clients.

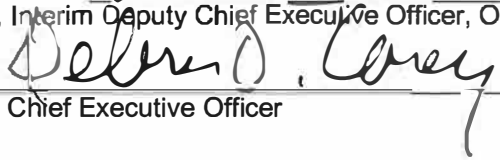
