NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:

The IDPH COVID-19 Contact Tracing Grant provides funding to support resource coordination by Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) to ensure health equity and address community and regional networks for successful sustainability of the local contact tracing program. These CBOs will primarily serve residents of communities of high economic hardship and discrimination and racism to conduct effective public health education and outreach to their communities. Additionally, they will provide enhanced COVID-19 case management and referrals for resources to support residents to minimize the spread of COVID-19 and address other social and economic impacts of the virus such as housing instability and lack of food. There will be a thorough and transparent process to effectively identify CBOs to serve communities most impacted by COVID-19.

This is a request to execute an agreement with Hektoen Institute for Medical Research to administer the competitive funding process for these contracts for CBOs to provide wraparound services for individuals affected by COVID-19. Contractor will provide administrative oversight of the funding, which includes contract management, monitoring grants for progress, reporting, and issuing payments for these organizations.

NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:

The IDPH COVID-19 Contact Tracing Grant provides funding to support a team of contact tracers. In order to meet the objectives of the grant and to hire people as quickly as possible, we request for a start-up team to first be hired at Hektoen Institute for Medical Research (Hektoen). Contractor will provide start-up staffing services for a limited number of temporary contact tracers to ensure the effective launch of the contact tracing program, as Cook County Health works to bring on the larger contact tracing workforce. This is a request to execute an agreement with contractor to provide staffing services for fifty (50) contact tracers, two (2) Case Investigation Supervisors, and eight (8) Case Investigators to ensure a timely start to this one-year funding period. This is related to the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) COVID-19 Contact Tracing grant that has been awarded to the Cook County Health Department of Public Health (CCDPH).
