

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


**NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:**  
Abbot Laboratories recently consolidated its St. Jude Medical, S.C, Inc. business unit with its Abbott Laboratories, Inc. business unit. This request combines the three contracts into a single new contract to obtain the provisions for pacemakers, Atrial Septal Defect, drug eluting stents, peripheral interventional suture devices and stents and disposables for both diagnostic and invasive procedures in the Cath and EP lab. Electrophysiology procedures started this year and will be expanded in the next few months. Electrophysiology procedures performed at CCH will save approximately \$3,000,000.00 that is currently sent out to other hospitals through an affiliated contract.


