On 03/09/2020, the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released final regulations for CMS Interoperability and Patient Access Final Rule (CMS Final Rule (CMS-9115-F)), to implement extensive requirements of health plans serving Medicaid, Medicare Advantage and the Federally Facilitated Exchanges. The implemented solution will ensure compliance with the Patient Access, Application Programming Interface (API) and the Provider Directory API rules. The Vendor will offer a Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR) server repository, third party access management (including member authentication and consent workflows), data transformations (both historical and ongoing loads), and ongoing support/maintenance of the platform. The contract will include two (2) one (1) year extension options.
