Data Collection Overview



- Internal Data Collection Forms
 - Employees are not asked about language skills apart from those in bilingual positions
 - Approximately 57 OUP employees self-identify as speakers of 13 languages
 - No internal data collection of demographic data
- External Data Collection
 - OUP has approximately 25 documents that collect demographic data; these documents follow federal census categories
 - Data on "preferred language" is not collected

Language Access



Internal

- Bilingual staff positions
 - 2 positions designated as bilingual; Spanish-speaking positions
 - Approx. 13 positions receive additional pay for language skills when used, as part of CBA
 - Positions are typically for direct communication with residents, partners, or workers
- Translations and interpretations
 - OUP Language Access Policy allows for compensation of staff if using language skills
 - Other translations and interpretations are contracted through language access vendor

External

- Language Line Solutions is the OUP language access vendor
 - Contract not to exceed \$114,000 but billed by usage
 - Budget is centrally managed from Office of the President

Opportunities



- Data Collection
 - Recommending and implementing subcategories that roll up to federal census categories as capacity allows
- Language Access
 - Promoting and building capacity for OUP departments and bureaus to leverage our language access vendor more often
