Application: Applicant, a Sanitary District organized under Illinois law, seeks a permitted Special Use in the R-4 Single Family Residence District to have its property declared a Special Use (PINs 18-17-301-019-0000, 18-17-301-020-000 & 18-17-301-021-000). This will permit the construction of a new water storage tank to replace the current obsolete elevated storage tank and for other improvements to its waterworks facility which has existed on the site for over forty years.

Recommendation: That the application be granted a one year extension of time.

The Subject Property consists of an approximately 1.75-acre parcel (containing 3 lots) owned and occupied by the LaGrange Highlands Sanitary District (District) since the 1960s.
