

# PROPOSED EXPENDITURES

## **EXPENDITURES**

The 2016 Executive Budget Recommendation proposes \$4,219 million in operating fund appropriations. Of the \$4,219 million, \$1,735 million is associated with General Fund (comprised of Public Safety & Corporate) spending. This includes a \$270.5 million appropriation for additional pension funding. Excluding this funding, the General Fund grows by 2.2%, despite absorbing an entire year of the impact of collective bargaining agreements and associated personnel costs that covered the first increases since FY2012, or the annual recurring cost associated with four fiscal years of salary adjustments. Full Time Equivalent (FTE) positions are budgeted to decrease by 253.9, or 1.6% in the General Fund in FY2016 versus FY2015.

The Health Enterprise Fund will have expenditures totaling \$1,644 million which represents a 7.1% increase from FY2015, largely reflecting the continued growth in the County's managed care program, absent this factor the increase is a more modest 1.9% year-over-year, again despite the fact that four fiscal years worth of employee salary adjustments are being absorbed for the first fiscal year on a full year basis in FY2016. Full Time Equivalents decrease by 10.9 in the Health Fund during FY2016.

Additional expenditure pressures are driven by the presidential election cycle which will lead to the Election fund increasing by \$22.7 million. Special Purpose Funds are increasing by \$29.8 million, primarily due to a \$25 million increase in legacy Debt Service costs while Grants increase by \$6.6 million as additional receipts are offset by associated spending.

## **EXPENDITURES BY TYPE**

The Executive Budget Recommendation calls for 73.2% of the General Funds to be spent on personnel expenses, including benefits. Excluding the additional funding being appropriated to stabilize the pension fund in 2016, personnel expenses represent 86.7% of the General Fund. Budgeted at \$1.269 million, it represents a 3.3% increase over 2015 appropriations in personnel spending. Personnel expenditures represent \$631 million or 38.4% of the Health Enterprise Fund. The primary driver of the increase in personnel costs is the compounded, full-year impact of the 2015 mid-year wage increases resulting from the settlement of Collective Bargaining Agreements that include increases of 1% from June 2013, 1.5% from June 2014 and 2% from June 2015 and the scheduled 2% cost of living adjustment effective December 1, 2015, effectively increasing base wages by 6.5% over FY 2015. These increases are partially offset by lower employee health benefit costs as a result of negotiated plan design changes and increased employee contributions agreed to in the labor agreements.

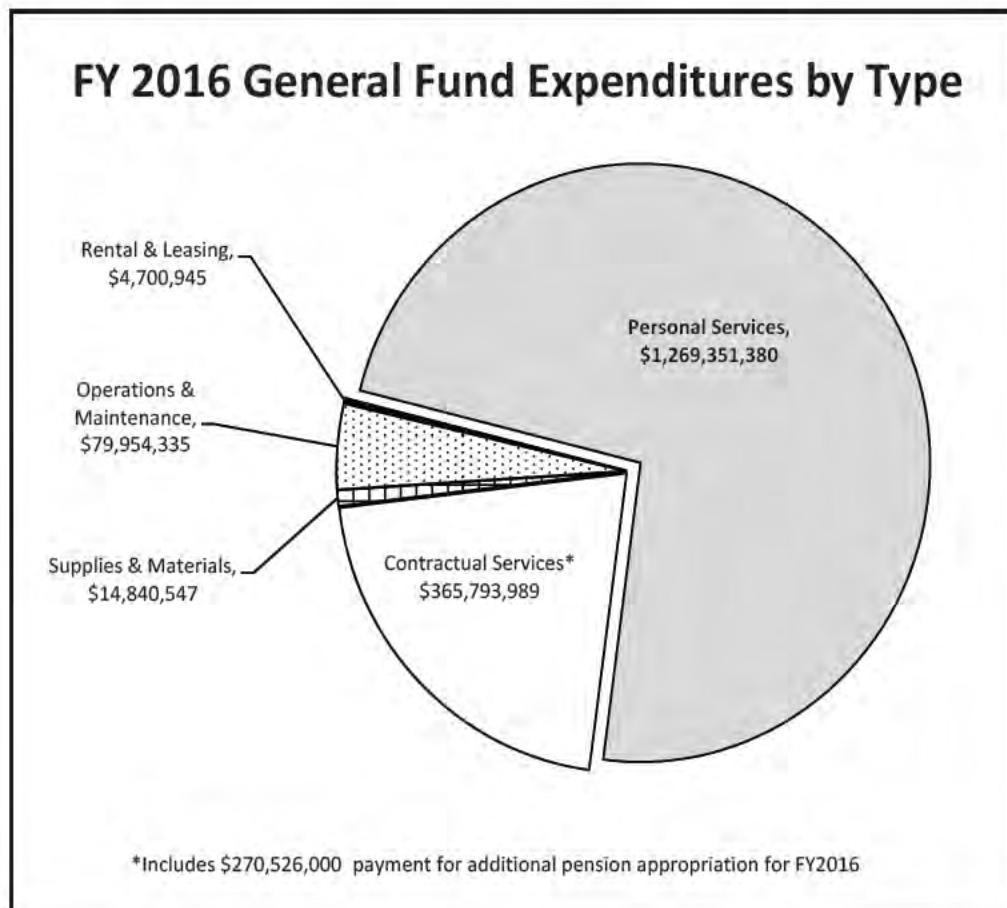

After more than \$10 million in cuts to non-Personnel Expenditures during the FY2016 budget process, non-personnel spending in the general Fund rose by 0.7% or \$1.3 million, when excluding an appropriation in 2016 for pension purposes. Notably, technology spending in the General Fund rose by 44%, and excluding technology spending non personnel in the General Fund actually dropped by \$7.5 million or 4.0%. In non-personnel expenditures from the General Fund, a total of \$99.5 million or 5.7% is spent on operations, maintenance, supplies, and rental and leasing which represents a 1.8% increase year-over-year. \$365.8

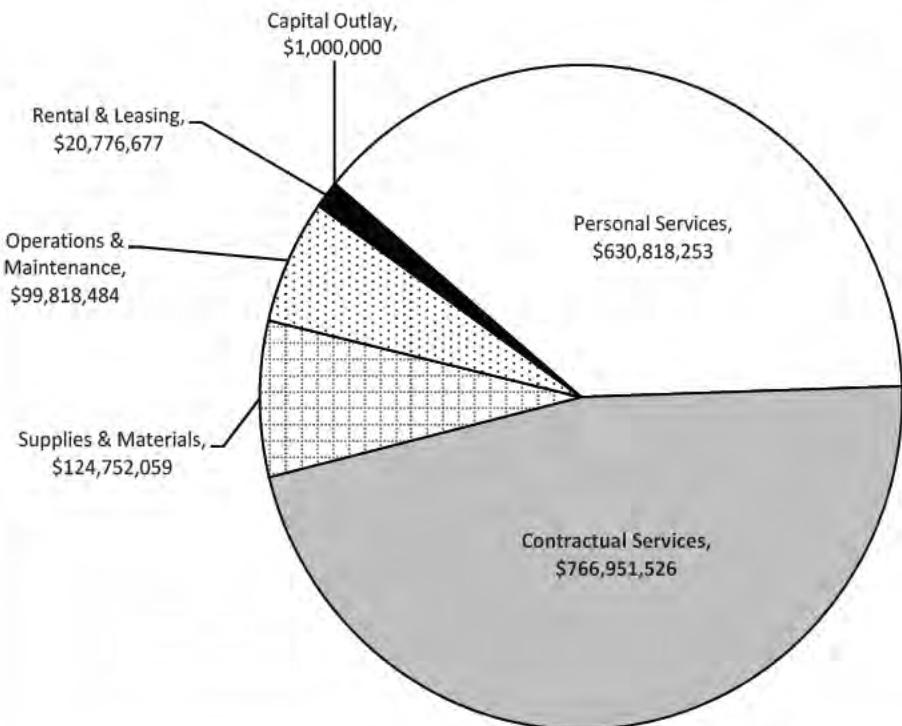
million or 21.1% is spent on contractual services, when including the additional \$270.5 million in funding for pensions appropriated in 2016, this amount is included as a transfer out to the Annuity and Benefit Fund (Fund 590), to address the outstanding unfunded pension liability in the County Employee's Annuity and Benefit Fund (the "Pension Fund"), and will be transferred to the Pension Fund subject to an intergovernmental agreement. Excluding the \$270.5 million pension appropriation, contractual services account for \$95.3 million or 6.5% of General Fund spending which represents a 2.2% decrease compared to 2015.

With respect to the Health Enterprise Fund, operations, maintenance, supplies, and rental and leasing represent \$245.3 million or 14.9% of expenditures while \$766.9 million or 46.6% is spent on contractual services which includes payments associated with third-party health care providers under CountyCare. Other expenditure drivers within the Health Fund are an increase of \$15 million in maintenance of hospital facilities in FY2016, which includes building upgrades and renovations aimed at improving operational effectiveness and improving patient experience. Additionally, there is a year-over-year increase of \$10 million related to the maintenance and upgrade of the Hospital System's electronic medical record system. Also in FY2016, the Cook County Health & Hospital System will expand its behavioral health services with \$16 million going towards contractual services providing counseling and treatment, as well as a 24-7 drop-in facility providing clinical assessments to detainees who committed minor, non-violent offense. In 2016, as the County continues to transition capital equipment purchases to increasingly be paid out of operating dollars, \$1.0 million will be spent on surgical equipment from the Health Enterprise Fund rather than from debt proceeds. In FY2017, the County plans to allocate a minimum of an additional \$10 million in general operating funds to capital equipment.

## EXPENDITURES BY FUNCTIONAL AREA

### GENERAL FUND

The Corporate and Public Safety Funds together make up the County's General Fund. Expenditure increases of \$302.4 million over FY2015 are driven primarily by the additional Board appropriated pension funding. Technology spending is also increasing in FY2016. Nearly all of the increase in technology spending is a function of increasingly budgeting for technology from operating funds versus the historic practice of bond funding essentially all technology spending. The aggregate increase in technology spending in the General Fund is estimated at 44% year over year in FY2016, a combined result of increasing costs for maintenance and support of legacy systems on existing contracts, as well as new contracts for infrastructure and equipment needed to facilitate the migration of Countywide data off of the AS400, Mainframe and other outmoded data storage systems. The County will also be budgeting separately for up front operating costs associated with capital purchases, such as server maintenance. Costs associated with systematically replacing Countywide switches and circuits that were not previously on a standard replacement cycle also contribute to the increase in technology spending. These costs include an increase in the overtime budget for infrastructure work necessary to prevent service interruptions.

## HEALTH ENTERPRISE FUND

The Health Fund shows growth of \$108.6 million over fiscal year 2015. The primary drivers of the cost increases continue to be implementation of the CountyCare program, which will be offset by increasing revenue associated with a full year of enrollment in the Family Health Plan and Seniors and Persons with Disabilities categories of membership. The growth in expenditures is directly associated with enrollment of members in CountyCare, as a significant amount of contractual services for these individuals at third-party healthcare providers and pharmacy related costs are associated with membership in the managed care program. Enrollment of Affordable Care Act (ACA) adults, Family Health Plan (FHP) and Seniors and Persons with Disabilities (SPD) is projected to grow modestly to nearly 180,000 members per month in FY2016, which in turn drives the growth in expenditures for this population and the health system overall.

In 2016, the Cook County Health and Hospitals System (CCHHS) is implementing initiatives aimed at improving patient care and controlling costs, including: launching a comprehensive behavioral health strategy that will enhance community-based mental health services in order to reduce unnecessary and costly emergency department visits, hospitalizations and detentions; investing in new and existing community-based outpatient clinical services and facilities and offering extended clinic hours and enhanced primary care, specialty care and diagnostic services; expanding the Patient Support Center to improve patient experience and utilization of services; and improving standardized data and reporting capabilities.

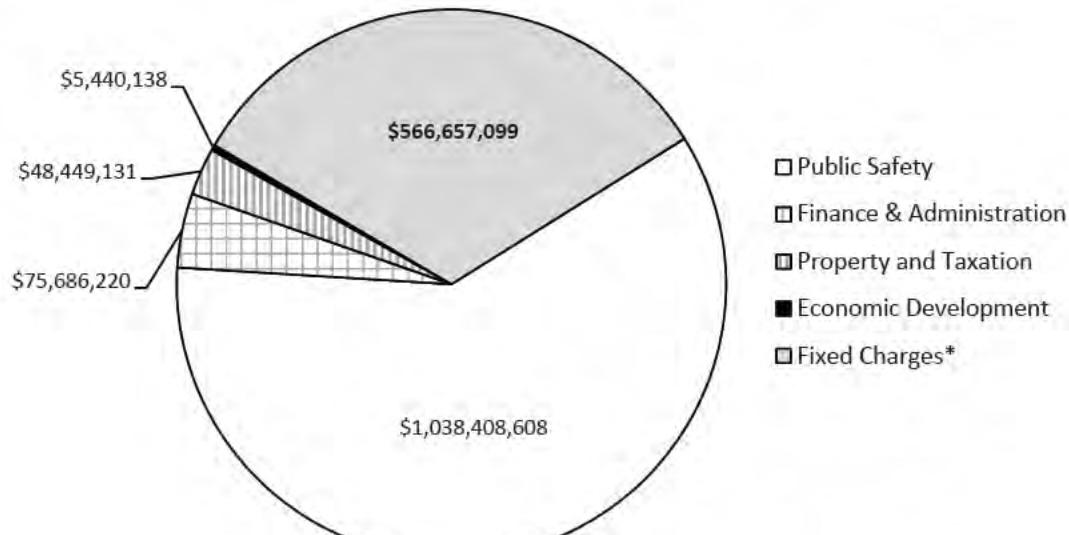

## PROGRAM AREAS

The pie-chart above provides the FY2016 President's Recommendation of General Fund Expenditures by program area: Public Safety, Finance and Administration, Property and Taxation, Economic Development, with an additional non-program specific category of Fixed Charges.

Fixed Charges can be defined as any fixed expense that recurs on a regular basis. The term "fixed charges", similar to that of overhead, is usually used when grouping expenses that are necessary to the continued functioning of the business but cannot be immediately associated with the products or services being offered. In this area the County has accounted for insurance, health benefits and payments for utilities, among other costs. Notably a number of items that were traditionally incorporated in fixed charges were allocated directly to the associated departments in FY2016 to the tune of \$17.9 million, with the most significant being the cost of real estate at 69 W Washington and the Daley Center. The growth in year-over-year expenses in this category of \$243.8 million is entirely a function of the \$270.5 million appropriation for additional pension funding in FY2016, reflecting the significant accumulated deficit at the Pension Fund. Absent the 2016 appropriation for pensions, Fixed Charges spending actually declined by \$26.7 million, reflecting the movement of costs directly to associated incurring cost center departments. In coming budgets the County will be continuing the trend of recent years of migrating additional program costs more directly to the associated departments. However, budgeting certain charges in Fixed Charges allows agencies to create more predictable budgets and estimate their cash flows more accurately for operating expenditures under their direct control, which will lead to a residual Fixed Charges even as program expenditures are increasingly moved out of fixed charges and directly into department budgets.

# PROPOSED EXPENDITURES

The distinct program areas can be further defined as:

## PUBLIC SAFETY

Cook County's Public Safety Goals are:

- Reduce the non-violent pre-trial detainee population
- Promote public safety for all communities across the County
- Promote reintegration of offenders
- Ensure fair & equitable access to justice
- Ensure an efficient court system to serve both criminal and civil justice functions

Cook County is responsible for the public safety of approximately 5.2 million residents. The public safety system makes up 59.9% of the General Fund and is comprised of the court system and the Sheriff's operations. The County operates the second largest unified court system in the world, which hears civil, criminal, and administrative cases. The Cook County jail is the largest single-site pre-trial detention facility in the United States and the Juvenile Temporary Detention Facility is the largest juvenile detention facility in the country.

In 2016, Public Safety expenditures are increasing by \$53.1 million or 5.4% while the overall FTE count is decreasing by 208.9 or 1.5% year-over-year. Notably, most of this increase is actually a function in the allocation of fixed charges into department budgets in 2016; net of this change the actual increase in spending is 3.8% year-over-year. The largest contributing factor to the 3.8% increase is the full-year impact of negotiated wage settlements associated with FY2012-2016 being fully absorbed in a single fiscal year. The increase in expenditures can also be partially attributed to a \$2.8 million increase related to juror fees as a result of State legislation increasing juror pay rates from \$17.20 to \$25-\$50. Another contributing factor is increased spending related to Adult Probation to accommodate the continuously increasing number of cases that require court-ordered Global Positioning System (GPS) monitoring, pre-trial supervisions and assessments which lead to a reduction in the jail population. The 2016 budget includes increased spending at the Juvenile Temporary Detention Center (JTDC) and Juvenile Probation to support new legislation that would keep youth who are currently automatically prosecuted as adults under juvenile jurisdiction.

Partially offsetting the increases above is a sustained reduction in the jail population which will allow the County to close and ultimately demolish Divisions 1, 3 and 17 of the jail. Those actions are expected to save more than \$3 million in operating costs during FY2016 and avoid \$188 million in capital costs over the next decade. Also in 2016 the Chief Judge's Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation Program will be eliminated, saving the County \$3.5 million, reflecting in large part the 50% reduction in mortgage foreclosure cases initiated in the Cook County Circuit Court chancery division during FY2015.

## FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION:

Cook County's Finance & Administration goals are:

- Promote proactive financial management and develop program performance goals and metrics for County operations
- Collect money owed efficiently and effectively
- Support county workforce needs through timely hiring
- Improve personnel oversight
- Procure goods fairly, timely, & cost-effectively

# PROPOSED EXPENDITURES

Cook County has approximately 23,400 employees and a 2016 budget of \$4.2 billion. Such a large organization requires sound management in the areas of budgeting, revenue collection, human resources, purchasing and fiscal oversight. In 2016, Finance and Administration's expenditures are increasing by \$4.2 million or 5.9% in total while the overall FTE count is decreasing by 37.0 or 4.3% year-over-year. Notably, most of this increase is actually a function in the allocation of fixed charges into department budgets in 2016; net of this change the actual increase in spending is 4.3% year-over-year. A primary driver of the 4.3% expenditure increase is a 44% year-over-year increase in General Fund technology spending, as the County funds investments and increasingly shifts these expenses away from the historic practice of 100% bond funding. In the coming years, the Bureau of Technology will strive to shift expenditures away from maintenance of legacy systems and towards investments that will transform County IT services to promote efficiency and improved customer experience for County residents. There are several significant technology projects being recommended in FY2016: continued investment in stabilizing the County's newly consolidated data center; the ongoing biometric Time and Attendance project; the implementation of a new Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system; investments in an integrated property tax system and integrated home-rule tax system to improve the experience for our taxpaying public; implementation of MS365 Cloud email servers; and coordinated data back-up and disaster recovery efforts. While these efforts will save money and will ensure more efficient and coordinated operations in the long run, the upfront costs involved in implementing these new systems are key drivers in increased technology spending for FY2016.

## PROPERTY AND TAXATION:

Cook County's Property & Taxation Goals are:

- Ensure a fair & accurate property valuation & appeals process
- Ensure efficient, timely, & effective assessment & billing
- Minimize duplicative property tax payments & process refunds quickly
- Increase taxpayer self-service transactions & access to information

On behalf of the County and underlying jurisdictions, Cook County government administers the second largest property taxation system in the United States, with 1.8 million parcels of real estate. Key functions of the system are: assessment, appeals, billing and tax collection. Expenditures associated with Property and Taxation are increasing \$1.2 million or 2.5% in 2016 while FTE count is decreasing by 7.0 or 1.0% year-over-year. Notably, most of this increase is actually a function in the allocation of fixed charges into department budgets in 2016; net of this change the actual increase in spending is 2.1% year-over-year. The Property & Taxation area continues to have positive outcomes, with 2015 representing the fourth consecutive year of timely tax billing following 35 years of late second installment billing. Investments in technology in this area will be designed to increase collaboration and investment in processes, most notably through an integrated property tax system that will commence a multi-year implementation in 2016. Amongst other office goals for 2016: the Assessor's Office will be expanding their Erroneous Exemptions program in 2016; the Board of Review will be launching their Digital Appeals Processing System in 2016; and the Recorder of Deeds looks to expand the use of e-Recordings.

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## ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

Cook County's Economic Development Goals are:

- Pursue regional economic development
- Increase access to living wage jobs
- Minimize the tax burden associated with Cook County government

The County is pursuing a consolidated approach to economic development through the Bureau of Economic Development under the Offices of the President. The Bureau oversees planning and community development, building and zoning in unincorporated Cook County, and zoning appeals. In 2016, expenditures associated with Economic Development are increasing slightly by \$89,216 and FTEs are decreasing by 1.0. In FY2016, economic development activities are also supported by \$109 million in grant funds at the Bureau of Economic Development as well as \$3 million in grant funding supporting the Cook County Land Bank Authority.

A major initiative in FY 2016 is the creation of the Regional and Strategic Initiatives unit, developed by redeploying existing staff resources and leveraging additional grant, foundation and corporate support to serve as an oversight for continued regional collaboration to improve the economic health of the communities with the greatest need. Since FY2014, the Bureau of Economic Development has doubled the volume of projects and the amount of private sector investment generated by the financial tools and incentives programs.

The Regional and Strategic Initiatives unit will spearhead the County's leadership and participation in the Chicago Regional Growth Initiative, Metro Chicago Exports, the Chicago Metro Metal Consortium and other regional opportunities and initiatives. The Bureau of Economic Development will continue to participate in and contribute to other critical projects throughout County government that have an economic development impact such as the Long Range Transportation Plan and the redevelopment of the Stroger Hospital campus. These projects are housed in other County bureaus, but have critical economic development implications.

# PROPOSED EXPENDITURES

## SPECIAL PURPOSE FUNDS, ELECTION FUND & GRANT EXPENDITURES

### SPECIAL PURPOSE FUNDS

In addition to the General Fund, the County's 2016 Executive Budget Recommendation includes the budgets for other County funds that are Special Purpose Funds. Special Purpose Funds are established for a specific and dedicated purpose, and are considered to be self-balancing. Total FY2016 expenditures in Special Purpose Funds are increasing \$29.8 million over FY2015. This increase is primarily attributable to the \$25.0 million increase in required debt service payments on legacy debt. Though the County had limited debt issuance, and the total bonded debt outstanding is projected to decline between FY2011 and FY2016 by approximately \$357.1 million or 9.4%, debt service on legacy bonded indebtedness will continue to rise in coming years.

### ELECTION FUND

In FY 2016, Election Fund expenditures are increasing by \$22.7 million over FY2015. This increase is driven by the 2016 presidential election as well as expenditures associated with changes in election laws that require same day registration at all precincts. These increases are partially offset by a decreased number of precincts over the last four years.

### GRANT FUNDS

The County receives grant funds from federal, state and private agencies for a variety of direct and indirect services provided under various program areas. In FY 2016, grant funding shows growth of \$6.6 million over FY 2015. Additional details can be found in the Grants section of this document.

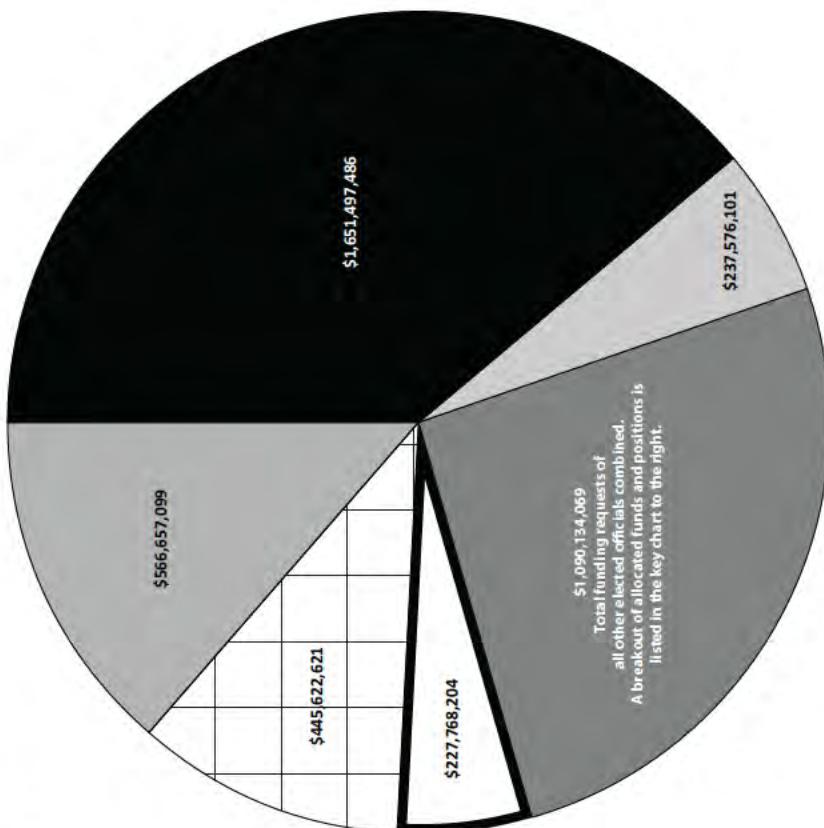
