Subject: Fiscal Impact Note on Item #20-4356 Temporary Equipment for

Reprocessing of Construction and Demolition Material

In accordance with Sec. 2-77 of the Cook County Code of Ordinances, this note is prepared to convey the fiscal impact of item #20-4356 Temporary Equipment for Reprocessing of Construction and Demolition Material.

Ordinance #20-4163 proposes that temporary rock crushing (TRC) machines be regulated, through the issuance of permits, in order to help reduce air pollution caused by the machines. The permit would include performance standards, setback requirements, and a pile height limit. The permit would be set at \$500 per month, extendable until all processable material has been crushed, with state and federal projects excluded from the permit fee.

The fee changes being proposed would lead to a forecasted revenue increase of \$10,000 per year, which assumes 20 permits issued per year.
