The Bureau of Technology now seeks Board approval of an amendment to the ITSP contract to incorporate additional business processes into the system.

Revenue Solutions, Inc. was previously awarded a contract through a competitive Request for Proposal (RFP) process by the State of Rhode Island. Cook County wishes to leverage this procurement effort.

In addition to ongoing telecommunications services, the County will receive much-needed upgrades to replace legacy telephone service with Voice over IP (VoIP) and increase bandwidth capacity to support mounting demand for data, video, and voice transfer.

This is a Sole Source Procurement pursuant to Section 34-139 of the Cook County Procurement Code.
