**Summary:** The Department of Risk Management is requesting authorization for the Chief Procurement Officer to enter into and execute a contract with Sedgwick Claims Management Services, Inc. This contract with Sedgwick Claims Management Services, Inc. is intended to provide Unemployment Compensation Claims Program Services. The vendor collaborates with County employers to ensure unemployment claims, hearings, and benefit charges are handled in a timely and cost-effective manner.
