WHEREAS, in 2008, Pastor Britt Sr. established Youth Outreach Ministries, where he preached biblical truths to inner city youth while teaching basic living skills to broaden their knowledge; and

WHEREAS, in 2009 Pastor Britt Sr. was ordained as a minister of the gospel; and

WHEREAS, in April 2011 Minister Curtis Allen Britt Sr., established Restoration Outreach Ministries as Pastor; and

WHEREAS, in June 2012 Restorative Outreach Ministries partner with Chicago City Colleges youth program names S.O.A.R. for the advancement of the youth; and

WHEREAS, in January 2018, Pastor Britt Sr. became the overseer of Women Uplifting Women Outreach.

WHEREAS, Pastor Britt continues to proclaim his life scripture as, "I will bless the Lord at all times, his praise shall continually be in my mouth." - Psalm 34
