#### PROPOSED RESOLUTION

#### COMMEMORATING NATIONAL MILITARY APPRECIATION MONTH IN COOK COUNTY

WHEREAS, May is National Military Appreciation Month, introduced by late Senator John McCain and designated by Congress in 1999, which gives our nation the opportunity to honor the service and sacrifice of servicemembers and their families; and

WHEREAS, not only do we reflect on Memorial Day the sacrifice and service of those who gave all, but the month also marks several other military anniversaries and events, including Military Spouse Appreciation Day, Loyalty Day, VE Day, Public Service Recognition Week, and Armed Forces Day; and

WHEREAS, this month as we celebrate current and former members of our military and their families, it is important to encourage all citizens to observe the month as a symbol of unity and recognize that as Americans we have more in common than not; and

WHEREAS, we honor the sacrifice of generations of military men and women by our commitment to community and country, and to preserving our freedoms and our democracy they so valiantly fought and continue to fight to preserve; and

WHEREAS, Loyalty Day (May 1<sup>st</sup>) is a day for the reaffirmation of loyalty to the United States, and to reflect on the proud heritage of our American freedom; and

WHEREAS, Public Service Recognition Week (the 1<sup>st</sup> full week in May) is set aside to honor the men and women who serve our nation as federal, state, county, and local government employees; and

**WHEREAS,** Victory in Europe Day or VE Day is observed May 8<sup>th</sup> to recognize May 8th, 1945 as the day when Germans throughout Europe unconditionally surrendered to the Allies marking the end of World War II in Europe; and

WHEREAS, Military Spouse Appreciation Day recognized on the Friday before Mother's Day is set aside to honor military spouses and recognizes the important role our military families play in keeping our Armed Forces strong and our country safe; and

**WHEREAS,** Armed Forces Day, celebrated on the third Saturday in May every year, honors everyone serving in the U.S. Military branches: Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, Navy, and Space Force; and

WHEREAS, Memorial Day observed on the last Monday in May, commemorates the men and women who died for our country while in military service; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Cook County Board of Commissioners are pleased to celebrate and honor our active and veteran military members past and present throughout the month of May;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the President and Members of the Cook County Board of Commissioners, in solidarity with National Military Appreciation Month, hereby commemorate May 2024 as Military
