	<p>Summary: The Department of Transportation and Highways respectfully submits for adoption a resolution appropriating funds for the improvement of the following County highways in northern Cook County:</p> <p>Euclid Avenue - Plum Grove Road to Hicks Road 9(City of Rolling Meadows)</p> <p>Illinois Road - Happ Road to the Edens Expressway, I-94 (Village of Wilmette)</p> <p>Illinois Road - Skokie Road to Locust Road (Village of Wilmette and New Trier Township)</p> <p>Locust Road - Illinois Road to Hill Road (Villages of Wilmette and Winnetka and New Trier Township)</p> <p>Naperville Road - West Bartlett Road to Lake Street (Village of Bartlett and Hanover Township)</p> <p>Techny Road - Sanders Road to Pfingsten Road (Village of Northbrook and Northfield Township)</p> <p>Willow Road - Waterman Avenue to Schoenbeck Road (Village of Arlington Heights and the City of Prospect Heights)</p> <p>This improvement shall consist of milling and resurfacing of the existing pavements with hot-mix asphalt and shall include drainage additions and adjustments, traffic control and protection, pavement marking, landscaping, engineering and other highway appurtenances.</p> <p>This improvement is needed to protect the public investment in the highway system and provide safe, efficient and sustainable highways.</p>
