These grant-funded staff will investigate and prosecute proactive and reactive human trafficking cases for the Office, will provide guidance and direction to other human trafficking ASAs and investigators, and will participate in all Task Force activities. The twenty-five percent match requirement for this award will be fulfilled with the in-kind salary and fringe benefits of the grant-funded investigator.
