	WHEREAS, Dr. Donna M. Alexander was born in East Orange, New Jersey on October 24, 1956;					
	<ul> <li>WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander received her undergraduate and Veterinariae Medicinae Doctoris degr from the University of Pennsylvania; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, while at the University of Pennsylvania, Dr. Alexander was the winner of the New Bol Esquire Award (1982), published in the Journal of Biochemistry (1978), and Journal of Animal Behavior (1982); and</li> <li>WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander helped catapult a historic decrease in animal euthanasia while previou working at Chicago Animal Care and Control from 1989 to 1999; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander, a true advocate who dedicated her life's work in the caring of all animal began her Cook County career in 2007; and</li> </ul>					
	WHEREAS, Dr. Donna Alexander vaccinated 4,500 animals every summer and even had the procedure timed to 15 seconds per shot; and					
	WHEREAS, this past week would have been the first mobile animal clinic headed by Dr. Alexander; and					
	WHEREAS, as tradition, Dr. Alexander would have performed every single shot like she has in the past; and					
	WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander also had other talents. Upon winning America's Junior Miss for 1974, she represented New Jersey and was given the grand opportunity to be a "Breck Girl."; and					
	WHEREAS, she was the first black woman to be chosen for the renowned shampoo campaign at age 17; and					
	WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander appeared in magazines such as Seventeen, Glamour and Mademoiselle and even had a few modeling jobs; and					
	WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander was a voracious reader, avid Scrabble and Jeopardy player, excell that liked to prepare exotic meals from different ethnic groups, and famously known for wearin that depicted animals; and WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander was called home on May 29th, 2018 and has rejoined her sister Jo Alexander Walker; and					

WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander will be sorely missed by colleagues, friends, family and also all the animals throughout Cook County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cook County Board of Commissioners, commemorate the life of Dr. Donna M. Alexander, and herewith expresses its sincere gratitude for the contributions she has made to the citizens and animals of Cook County, Illinois; and
