	<ul> <li>WHEREAS, Wilson Frost was born on December 27, 1925 to General Frost and Freddie Bonds in Cairo, Illinois; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, Wilson attended Phillips Academy High School in Chicago and earned his bachelor's degree from Fisk University in Nashville, Tennessee; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, he returned to Chicago to attend the Chicago-Kent College of Law, receiving his Juris Doctor in 1958; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, after earning his law degree, Wilson joined the firm Frost, Sherard, Howse &amp; Coleman, where he continued on as a partner until 1973; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, in 1973, Wilson formed Meyer &amp; Frost, later Frost &amp; Greenblatt, where he remained until his retirement in 1998; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, Wilson became involved in politics and won the aldermanic election representing the 21st Ward in 1967 and the 34th Ward in 1971; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, in December 1976, Wilson was named Chairman of the Finance Committee for the City of Chicago; and</li> </ul>				
	WHEREAS, Wilson's dedication to public service did not end at the City of Chicago; and WHEREAS, Wilson went on to be Commissioner of the Cook County Board of Tax Appeals; and WHEREAS, Wilson retired as a Commissioner in 1998; and				
	WHEREAS, Wilson was a Cook County resident who selflessly served the public and relentlessly worked to improve the community; and				
	WHEREAS, Wilson was also a great mentor and was kindly known as "The Godf
