Summary: This grant will allow the Office to dedicate one Postconviction DNA Assistant State's Attorney and one Postconviction DNA Specialist that will form the Postconviction DNA Program. This Program will solely focus on postconviction cases specifically dealing with DNA. The grant-funded staff will review postconviction cases to identify those in which DNA testing could prove the actual innocence of a person convicted of a violent felony offense(s) as defined by State law, locate biological evidence associated with such postconviction cases, and facilitate DNA analysis of appropriate biological evidence.
