Summary: The purchase of 6,800 eLearning licenses will be used to train officers on the new JMS system. Tribridge (the creator of the new JMS System) will provide electronic learning to the Cook County Sheriff's Office. This scope

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change will provide several benefits. First, correctional staff will be trained and tested at their work stations, without having to come to a dedicated training center. Staff will be able to take the training multiple times if they are unfamiliar with a specific section of the JMS system. Staff could also be quickly trained on new areas of the system. We will also have the ability to track and provide confirmation of individual staff training and test results.
