## PROPOSED RESOLUTION

## HONORING OAK LAWN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE PRESIDENT ADAM WOODWORTH

WHEREAS, Adam Woodworth currently serves as the Executive Director of the Children's Museum of Oak Lawn; and

WHEREAS, Adam Woodworth has helped to transform the Children's Museum in Oak Lawn into a dynamic institution that positively impacts the experiences of local children through play-based education; and

WHEREAS, Adam Woodworth serves on the National Conference Committee of Children's Museums and is a Board Member of the Association of Children's Museums; and

WHEREAS, Adam Woodworth previously served as Vice President of the Oak Lawn Chamber of Commerce; and

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Cook County Board of Commissioners does hereby extend its warmest wishes and congratulations to Adam Woodworth on the occasion of his being named President of the Oak Lawn Chamber of Commerce, and join all who have had the pleasure of working with him in wishing him continued success; and
