PROPOSED RESOLUTION

HONORING MISERICORDIA AND THE HEARTZINGERS

WHEREAS, Misericordia is a center and home for over 600 residents with disabilities located in Rogers Park; and

WHEREAS, the *Heartzingers* are a choral ensemble of residents of Misericordia; and

WHEREAS, with the help of volunteers Bob and Madge Erlenbaugh, who began their work in 2006, *Heartzingers* is composed of almost fifty singers and signers; and

WHEREAS, the *Heartzingers* have been serving at countless Chicago and Cook County functions and at Misericordia's campus; and

WHEREAS, the *Heartzingers* have sung the National Anthem for the Cubs and White Sox, and performed with James Taylor, Paul Simon and most recently with Miguel Cervantes from the production of *Hamilton*; and

WHEREAS, most recently, this highly talented singing group performed holiday caroling for the Cook County Tree Lighting Ceremony with President Preckwinkle; and

WHEREAS, the *Heartzingers* believe in the motto: Everything the choir sings or signs must be true, kind and necessary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the President and the Cook County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the residents of Cook County, recognize Misericordia and the *Heartzingers* for its essential contribution to the health and viability of Cook County; and
