### **PROPOSED RESOLUTION**

#### **REQUESTING A HEARING OF THE LEGISLATIVE AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS THE COUNTY ENTERING INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS CONCERNING TRAININGS AND INVESTIGATIONS INTO POLICE OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTINGS IN SUBURBAN COOK COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, many Suburban Cook County cities and villages lack the proper resources to investigate police officer-involved shootings; and

**WHEREAS**, Cook County Sheriff Tom Dart on January 18, 2018 sent a letter to all Suburban Cook County Police Departments offering assistance from the Sheriff's office for training on proper police conduct and to assist in the investigation of police officer-involved shootings (Attached as Exhibit A);

**WHEREAS**, Cook County has a tradition of entering into intergovernmental agreements with the cities and villages of Cook County to provide training and investigative help; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations Committee hold a hearing on the best way to provide assistance to Cook County cities and villages to provide training and investigative help for police officer-involved shootings.
