Summary: This increase and renewal option will allow the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer to continue to receive on-going licenses, maintenance, support and hosting services for the contract management system which is being used County-wide since its implementation in 2012. Gimmel Solutions' system was originally selected to implement a Contract Management System to provide a web-based application for all County User Agencies to view all phases of procurement development; records and document management; and storage of contract documents.
