Summary: The Department of Transportation and Highways respectfully request the approval of the proposed Contract between Cook County and Peralte-Clark, LLC, of Arlington Heights, Illinois.

Assignments may include but are not limited to completing preliminary engineering and environmental (Phase I) studies for intersections, small roadway segments, roadway corridors, structures, and multi-use paths; performing traffic, crash, structural, or other supporting analyses as needed; completing feasibility studies; identifying and preparing applications for grant funding; and other tasks as directed. Phase I studies prepared under this contract will be completed in accordance with applicable policies from the County and the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT).

This contract is awarded pursuant to a publicly advertised Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in accordance with the Cook County Procurement Code. Peralte-Clark, LLC, was selected based on established evaluation criteria.
